The State Games of America is a biennial amateur multi-sport event held in North America. It is organized by the National Congress of State Games. Athletes qualify for the SGA by earning a medal in their respective State Games in the previous two years. First held in St. Louis, MO, in 1999, the next SGA will be 2017 in Grand Rapids, MI. There are currently 30 states conducting or organizing statewide sports festivals known as State Games. This year, 40 RRFSC members competed at the Keystone State Games, earning us the 2nd place club trophy! Club members who placed 1st. 2nd or 3rd in an event qualified for SGA 2017.

Ice Monitors

We are in need of Ice Monitors on Monday & Friday afternoons, especially leading up to competitions. Ice Monitors monitor the running of music/programs, by helping to play music and keep track of the skaters sign-up sheet. This helps to keep things moving and allows more

skaters to run programs. We will happily give everyone instructions and rules.

Ice Rules Reminder

Each skater may run 3 programs (any program or dance even if it's the same one for all 3) maximum outside of a private lesson per day.

When in a private lesson, it is up to the coach what programs/how many a student will run during their lesson time. Lesson run thrus are in addition to the 3 maximum programs run outside of a lesson.

Only the skater "on deck" should be standing by the monitor/music box and wearing a program vest. Skaters should not be skating around in vests outside of programs.

A skater's name may only be on the waiting list for a program for one program at a time. Once that program has been run they can sign up for the next program.
